THE 2020 VISUAL STYLE

Vocational education and training (VET) has the capacity to empower all people with the skills they need for a satisfying personal and professional life. VET is related to education, learning and creating networks that allow people to grow as individuals and professionals.

For this reason, the refreshed visual style highlights the idea of growing knowledge. To convey this idea visually the folder tab has been used as a graphic element.

The folder is an object in which information is stored and can be organised by themes. Also, it is socially related to education and work environments. VET provides people with initial qualifications for the labour market and provides adults with the means to upskill /reskill throughout their lives. These two pillars are unified in the form of folders. Each of the folders that represent VET refers to different information inputs. Each tab is a folder with new information that we can discover.



The leaf icon

The leaf is an icon that represents the brand and that is aligned with the current visual style. Also, this icon can be represented in several forms and colours to create a heterogeneous and fresh look. The leaf can include other elements, like images that represent the values of the European Vocational Skills Week.



 This leaf icon will be used as a profile image or as a favicon.

This icon coexists with other representations of the leaf that are included in the visual style. Therefore, the proposal maintains these symbols to create continuity in the refreshed graphic proposal.

The European Vocational Skills Week images show the **discovery** of the learning process. In addition, they include a new vision in which people are **working**, **striving** and **learning** to convey the idea of growth and to visualise contexts in which VET generates **change** and **improvement**.





COLOUR PALETTE

The current palette of European Vocational Skills Week is colourful. This proposal aims to maintain this vibrancy in the updated colour palette.

The refreshed Week colour palette aims to create a range of colours that distinguish the brand. For this reason, the previous palette has been revised to create an updated one that creates a more **recognisable identity**.

The colours have therefore been reduced to six different and heterogeneous tones that create a **contemporary**, **fresh** and **bright** palette.

Colour application

Colour differentiates the elements that make up the European Vocational Skills Week campaign. Each of these colours relates to an element of the campaign:





TYPOGRAPHY

The Arial font family should be used for all promotional material for events that **are not** organised/co-organised by the European Commission. There are three types of Arial font weights and each has a specific use:

- Arial Regular: All body text
- Arial Bold: Any key information that needs to be highlighted
- Arial Black: All titles

The EC Square Sans Pro font family should only be used for promotional material for events that **are** organised/co-organised by the European Commission. There are four types of EC Square Sans Pro font weights and each has a specific use:

- EC Square Sans Pro Light and Regular: All body text
- EC Square Sans Pro Medium: Any key information that needs to be highlighted
- EC Square Sans Pro Bold: All titles

For promotional materials created using programmes from the Microsoft Office Suite such as Word or PowerPoint, Arial should be used even if the materials are produced for events that are organised/co-organised by the European Commission.
